#### IMPORTANT NOTE

1. The applicant must take due care while filling up the form (online). The information provided by the applicant in his/her form shall not be changed or altered in any case and the University will not entertain such requests under any circumstance. The University shall not be liable for any mistake made by the applicant.
2. In case if the number of registered candidates at any of the examination centres is less than 100 (One Hundred), then in such case the registered candidates will be allotted the nearest centre.
3. There is no provision of revaluation/scrutiny.
4. Only such RTI applications shall be entertained which are received within 60 days from the declaration of final result.
5. Each candidate will also have to mention his / her Sub-Category along with his / her overall category i.e. UR, SC, ST and OBC.
6. To give the benefit to students who have passed the eligibility examination in the current year 2018-19 a deduction of 5% marks would be made for every gap year from the obtained marks. The maximum deduction would be 15%.
7. Every candidate will have to declare any disciplinary action/police action against him.
8. The Registration Fees for General and OBC Category is Rs. 1600/- and SC/ST/PH/EW is Rs. 800/-.
9. The minimum qualifying marks in Entrance Test are 30% for Unreserved Category, 27% for OBC. There is no negative marking.
10. Every candidate can view his/her Answer Sheet within one month of declaration of Results by paying a token amount Rs. 100/- at Pravesh Bhawan.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

The minimum qualification for admission to the MBA programme shall be graduation from a recognized Institution (Degree Course of at least three years duration with separate annual/semester examination system) from any stream. Students appearing in the final year examination of the undergraduate class are also be permitted to apply, subject to the condition that they furnish their final graduation pass result not later than the date of admission.

## **NO. OF SEATS**

51 seats, The seats may be change as per HRD recommendations in MONIRBA and 51 seats in GBPSSI.

## **RESERVATION**

As per University Rule.

## **FOREIGN STUDENTS**

Admission of foreign nationals shall be made strictly as per recommendations of the Foreign Students Advisor of the University as supernumerary seats. Foreign students recommended from time to time by the Government of India shall be exempted from Admission Test.

## **REQUIREMENT TO APPEAR FOR ADMISSION TEST**

All applicants, except the foreign national applicants applying through the prescribed channel shall have to appear in the Admission Test.

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

The admission to the MBA course shall be based on Admission Test comprising of Written and Oral Tests (Group Discussion & Personal Interview). All tests shall be conducted only in English medium.



**WRITTEN TESTS (300 MARKS):**

The written tests shall judge applicants for proficiency in written communication, intelligence, propensity to observe facts and use them, propensity to grasp and use quantitative and scientific tools, general awareness, logical thinking, reasoning power, aptitude for management learning and practice, and maturity in terms of personality.

(i) Communication Ability in English	40 questions	80 Marks
(ii) Aptitude and Reasoning	40 questions	80 Marks
(iii) General Awareness	40 questions	80 Marks
(iv) Quantitative Aptitude	30 questions	60 Marks
<b>Total</b>	<b>150 question</b>	<b>300 Marks</b>

**Note: - Admission Test shall be held through Online Mode only at the centre allotted by the University on the Admit Card.**

**Qualification for GD & PI :**

The number of candidates to be called for GD and PI Test shall be three times the number of Seats in the MONIRBA for MBA and GBPSSI for MBA-RD.

**Group Discussion (50 Marks)**

Group leadership test shall be done by grouping the applicants in viable groups and conducting discussion on chosen themes to test the applicant's leadership ability, group behaviour, and adjustment with group dynamics.

**Personal Interview (50 Marks)**

Personal Interview will be held for each candidate separately to test overall suitability of a candidate for doing M.B.A.



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## **FINAL LIST OF SELECTED CANDIDATES:**

The final list of selected candidates shall be drawn on the basis of the overall performance of the candidates in the Written and GD & PI Tests. Every candidate has to appear in all Written Tests and GD & PI Tests. Thus, a candidate, who is, for whatsoever reason, does not present himself in any of the above Test(s) shall not be considered for final admission. Final result shall be declared on the official website of University of Allahabad and displayed on the notice board of MONIRBA and GBPSSI.

If the score of two or more candidates is identical in overall, Admission Test, Admission shall be granted on the following basis :

- Score in the Written Test.
- Percentage Marks scored in Graduate Examination, in case of score in written test is also identical,
- By drawing a lottery. If the marks in Graduate Examination are same.

**A student after being declared successful must deposit his fees with in stipulated timing if a student does not collect his/her Intimation Card or deposit the fee by the required date he/she the candidate next in merit will be given admission.**

## **TEST CENTRES**

**The written test shall be held at Prayagraj, Bareilly, Bangalore, Gorakhpur, Kanpur, Kolkata, Lucknow, New Delhi, Thiruvantpuram and Varansai.**–The candidate shall have the option to appear from any one of the specified centers. In case the number of applicants opting for a centre is less than 100, the University shall have the right to cancel that centre and direct the candidates to appear in any nearest centre registered by them in their application forms or as decided by the University. The Group Discussion/Personal Interview for the short-listed candidates shall be conducted only at Prayagraj. The Candidates shall have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay for appearing in the written and oral tests and shall not be entitled to any TA/DA.
