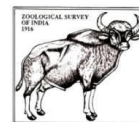

**Job requirements:**

- Extensive field surveys are to be conducted in Himalayan region of three states of North East India (Sikkim, West Bengal & Arunachal Pradesh) for the collection and study of moths pollinating different floral components.
- Recording of field observations on moths visiting different flowering plants.
- Laboratory Work: Identification of moths and pollens. Dissections, Slide preparations and photography of different moths and pollens.
- Preparation of monthly, quarterly, half yearly and annual progress reports of the projects.

**Place of Work:** Zoological Survey of India, Kolkata with the liability of extensive and long field surveys to the Himalayan region of three states of North East India (Sikkim, West Bengal & Arunachal Pradesh).
